Support in the community extended to preschool

In 2024, approx. **183 aid packages** were distributed (+10%, approx. 166 in 2023), including food, hygiene and disinfection articles and adult nappies.

Typical foods are rice, maize meal, flour, oil and sugar.



On average, a **package costs EUR 33** and **feeds a family for several weeks.**



A **preschool** in the township was **newly supported with basic equipment** in 2024:

Chairs, colouring books, blackboards, chalk and blankets were provided.



Gifts were also distributed to **25 children at Christmas**, including school bags, colouring books and pencils.

The social worker continues to support township residents very proactively

As there are again slightly **more people attending church services** (approx. 30 every Sunday, only approx. 10 in 2023), regular additional prayer sessions will be offered again.



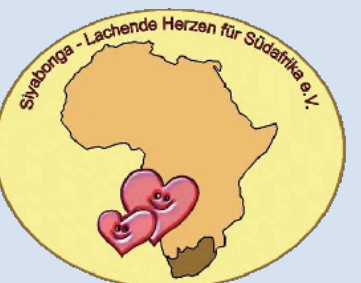
School uniforms were again financed **for 13 children**, which are a prerequisite for school attendance.

The uniform jackets, pants and shoes cost approx. **33 EUR** per child (+32%, approx. 25 EUR in 2023).

Vegetables and lettuce seeds were again provided for the vegetable patches. In addition, **water containers** were financed (10 large tons for approx. 38 EUR each).

Vegetables were often stolen from the farm's greenhouse. They are now **only grown on the private plots.**

Fewer trips to the clinic and authorities (depending on need, approx. 8 trips each, -20%).
